- **Expeditionary Security Management.** Providing end-to-end security solutions for remote or high-risk sites, including: identifying, vetting, and integrating local security personnel; establishing Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for consistency of security operations; deploying an expatriate Local Security Manager (LSM); and, delivering training, oversight, and governance to maintain high standards of security and compliance. - **Employee Duty of Care.** Ensuring duty of care for deployed expatriate personnel through our Travel Risk Management (TRM) app for real-time monitoring, alerts, and SOS emergency services; and accredited training such as Security Awareness in Foreign Environments (SAFE) for staff working in or travelling to unfamiliar locations, and Hostile Environment Awareness Training (HEAT) for staff operating in semi-permissive or hostile areas. All aligned with ISO 31030 for comprehensive travel risk management.
- **Emergency Response.** Providing emergency response through our 24/7/365 Operations Centre, and if required, expert Crisis Management support.
